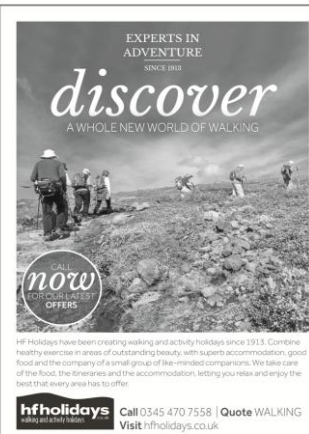

**CANCELLATIONS** - members MUST inform the leader AS SOON AS POSSIBLE if they have to cancel on Special Buses to allow other members the chance to take their place. If a cancellation is made with less than 2 days notice, and the vacant seat is unable to be filled, then members will be expected to pay a contribution of £5.00 towards the cost of the coach.

**DISCLAIMER** - members and walkers are reminded that they attend walks/activities in this programme at their own risk and they are responsible for their own personal safety.

**MEMBERS USING STICKS - SAFETY WARNING** - please be aware of the potential danger caused by swinging sticks whilst walking and by sticks being carried in rucksacks, particularly whilst climbing over stiles.

**MEETING PLACE:** The Club meets on South Sherwood Street for Special Buses. Private Transport rambles currently meet outside the Nottingham Mechanics, North Sherwood Street. However, please check with the walk leader, because road works, waiting restrictions, etc., are continually changing. Please confirm public transport and evening ramble times with the walk leader.
