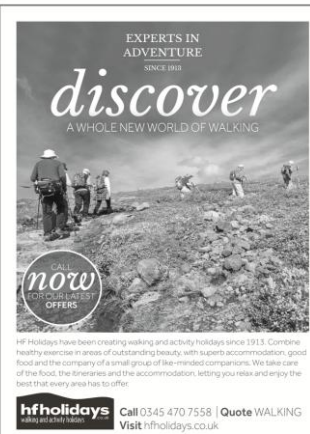

SPECIAL BUS WALKS

The number of people on the coaches that we have run since the lifting of lockdown restrictions is giving cause for concern.

On both coaches we have had less than 30 people, both resulting in a substantial financial loss to the club.

If we continue at this rate the club fund will rapidly become depleted and the club will become unable to function.

None of us want to get to that situation.

We will be choosing destinations for coaches where there are alternative attractions to the walks, which will continue to be offered.

If you feel that you can no longer take part in the walks, please come along on the coaches and enjoy a day out with others of similar ability and outlook.

IMPORTANT MESSAGES:

CANCELLATIONS: Members **MUST** inform the leader **AS SOON AS POSSIBLE** if they have to cancel on Special Buses to allow other members the chance to take their place. If a cancellation is made with less than 2 days notice, and the vacant seat is unable to be filled, then members will be expected to pay a contribution of £5.00 towards the cost of the coach.

REMINDER OF RULE 13: Members should not walk in front of the leader!!

MEMBERS USING STICKS - SAFETY WARNING: Please be aware of the potential danger caused by swinging sticks whilst walking and by sticks being carried in rucksacks, particularly whilst climbing over stiles.
